





- The road construction activities in Subansiri basin has seen significant increase with construction of roads to Taksing, Huri, Maza, Nacho being speeded up.
- Together with BRO and NHIDCL, we are now constructing around 2000 km of road per year.
- The work on strategically important Sela Tunnel and Nechiphu tunnel is moving at a fast pace and expected to complete in 2022.





- This year being the Golden Jubilee year, we have taken the Mission to inaugurate 365 infrastructure projects by infusing sufficient funds to complete those and dedicate those to the service of the citizens.
- "Chief Minister's Comprehensive State Road Development Plan"to be provided with improved funding.
- Itanagar-Jote Road connecting NIT campus has been sanctioned with an estimated cost of Rs. 90 Cr as first State Highway.
- Signs of reverse migration back to villages due to improved road connectivity.
- Construction of major infrastructure projects like District Secretariat at Ziro, Outdoor stadium at Yupia and Ziro has been completed.
- Miao-Vijoynagar to be completed soon.
- Construction of Multi-storied RCC building and auditorium for Govt Higher Secondary School at Daporijo, District Hospital at Longding, integrated water supply at Chongkham and Jia has been completed.
- Under District Head Quarter Township roads township roads at Seppa, Yupia, Basar, Boleng, Hawai, Khonsa are targeted for completion. Road from NH-52 to Nari ADC office, Double lane Steel Arch bridge at Borum, Arunachal Guest House at Guwahati, Road to Tali ADC HQ and Steel Arch Bridge over Kumey river on Yangte-Tali road are targeted for completion in next few months.
- Hollongi Airport scheduled to be commissioned in August 2022.
 Till date Rs. 175 Cr has been invested on the external infrastructure development of the Hollongi airport.
- Heliport facilities at Ziro, Daporijo, Tuting, Walong, Itanagar and Yingkiong to enable faster and reliable access to these remote locations.
- Government of India has agreed, in principle, for construction of New ALG at Dirang and Development of an old abandoned ALG at Anini for Civil and Military operations







- Airports at Pasighat and Tezu have been completely operationalised.
 - The total road network of our twin capital cities is around 330 kms out of which we have taken up 260 kms for upgradation. Under Phase-I, Rs. 100.00 Cr was sanctioned for the total road length of 94 kms which is targeted for completion by September 2022. Some roads with total length of 27 km are also being taken up under Smart City project.

- Arunachal Pradesh has been adjudged the Most Improved Small State in categories of Infrastructure and Governance by a leading media group.




Change in GSDP (Current Prices)




